Leave of Absence requests.

As we begin the new academic year, we respectfully remind parents that only in exceptional circumstances will absences be authorised:-

- Leave of absence will only be authorised in extenuating circumstances
- Reasons relating to financial advantages for example will not be authorised.
- If the permission to take leave is not granted and the pupil still goes on holiday, the absence will be unauthorised and referred to the Education Welfare Officer as to whether further action is required.

Breakfast Club

We will be trialing a Breakfast Club from Monday 11th September. It will run from 8:00am until 8:45am. A selection of cereals, toast and various spreads and jams as well as fruit and yogurt will be available. The breakfast session will be supervised by Mrs Alway (lunchtime supervisor) and Mrs Slater our school cook will prepare the food and drinks. The cost will be £2:50 per session and depending on uptake may well be less.

Parent Pay

The cost of a school meal has increased to £2.20 from 1^{st} September. In order to relieve the school office of the handling of cash/cheques, we have signed up to Parent Pay.

Account activation letters have been sent home via satchel post today. Please take a moment to set up your child's account to pay for dinners (Years 3-6). Once established, we hope to add the facility to pay also for swimming lessons (Years 3-6), the Breakfast Club and the Go Active Multi-Sports Clubs.

The pupils School Bank (Years 1-6) will continue to operate and will be open on a Tuesday from 8.30am. Please use the bank to pay for all school trips. It really helps to teach our pupils about the importance of saving and indeed using the banking system.
