


BIG Question: What makes our World so Wonderful?

For our focus we will be discussing what is wonderful in the world around us. Beginning with an introduction to the human life cycle, we will explore how we grow and make simple timelines. We will think about the past, present and future and enjoy exploring artefacts from the past. What observations will we make of the past and present?

Reception will then build on their knowledge through learning about minibeast life cycles. We will ask questions and compare different minibeasts. Year R will be watching caterpillars grow into butterflies and take a trip out for a bug hunt. The children will be learning exciting new facts, extending their vocabulary and using all of their senses through a variety of provision designed to facilitate the best learning.
