Dear Parents/Carers,

Celebrations began this week to mark the 50th year on the current site at Mongleath Rd. The week began with an assembly where I shared my memories of being a pupil starting school at St Mary's in 1966. At that time the school was situated in the Church Hall off Killigrew Street. In September 1967, the school moved into a brand new modern school building here on Mongleath Rd, costing £42,000. One hundred and twenty seven pupils attended from September 1967 and this number has grown to two hundred and seventeen today.

It was so lovely to welcome past members of staff and friends who joined us for the 50th Anniversary Mass on Wednesday. They enjoyed a guided tour conducted by our Class 6 ambassadors and had an opportunity to look at old photos, press cuttings and slides. Many of our special visitors were amazed to see how the building had changed from five classes to seven classes with additional breakout rooms, offices and an enlarged hall.

St Mary's School has always been such a very special place and I feel extremely privileged to have led the school for the last thirteen years, building on the wonderful work of previous heads, Mr D'Silva, Mrs Beresford, Mr O'Brien and Mr Hannon.

Further celebrations are being planned for the Spring and Summer Terms involving ex pupils and staff which we will keep you informed about. We're also working on a short film about our school. In the meantime, we would be extremely grateful if you could bring in any photos or memorabilia which we can add to our archive.

I would like to thank local businesses who have sponsored future events and activities for this special year. These include, Watson Marlow, Hine Downing and Pendennis Shipyard.

Christmas Performances 2017

We're looking forward to welcoming you to our Christmas performances. This year the performances are more low key and shorter. The programme for the performances is as follows:-

To meet health and safety requirements, we will be issuing tickets for all performances from Tuesday 28th November. There will be no cost for these tickets, but as usual there will be a collection at the end of each performance. This is a St Mary's tradition to consider the needs of others at this special time of the year, a time of giving. All donations will be distributed amongst the children's chosen charities.

Each family will be issued two tickets for each performance, except for the Reception Class where four tickets per family will be available due to the reduced numbers performing. If you don't require some of your allocated tickets, please return them to the School Office by Monday 4th December when they can be re-issued to families who request additional tickets. Please note additional tickets will only be issued from the 5th December.

Please note entry without a ticket will not be permitted.

Afternoon Performances

Parents and visitors are politely asked not to arrive on Tuesday or Wednesday afternoon, before 1:45pm as lunches are served from 12 till 1:30pm. The hall has to be cleared and set up for the afternoon performances. Entrance will be through the green gate leading to the Reception Class playground for the afternoon performances.

After the afternoon performances on Tuesday and Wednesday, siblings in other classes may be collected if this is before the usual finishing time. Please wait on the playground for your child/ren to be collected from other classes and not in the foyer or inside the building where space is limited.

Evening Performances

Entrance to the school for the evening performances is through the front door.

Every year we ask parents **not** to return their child/ren for the evening performances before 6:00pm as the school is **closed** until staff are back on the premises to supervise them. As all the school will have seen the performances, please ensure seats are for adults only.
