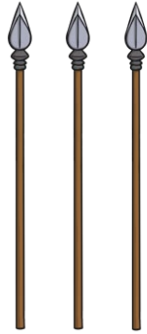


Maths

- Create a Venn Diagram of modern tools, Stone Age tools and tools that were created during the Stone Age that we still use today.
- People in the Stone Age used marks when they were counting. Can you count how many toys or books you have and use tally marks to record this?



Outdoor Learning

- Use natural materials to create a picture of the Stone Age.
- Make a den using natural resources- take photos
- Using a variety of materials, create a small model of a Stone Age dwelling or monument, such as Stonehenge



English

- List all the jobs that people had to do during the Stone Age.
- Can you list at least ten jobs?
- Create an acrostic poem using the word 'Stone Age'.



- Create a Stone Age quiz to test your friends and family. Who can get the best score?
- Imagine you are an archaeologist. Place small objects in sand, soil or rice and ask someone to find them using a small brush (like a toothbrush or make up brush) or teaspoon. Ask someone to hide objects for you to find.
