

Year 4 RE Focus – Pentecost Serving

This term our RE focus is Pentecost - Serving

The children's Big Question is: *What's so important about new life?*





The children will be reflecting on this and asking: How can good news change the way you feel? How do you think we might live if we allow the Holy Spirit to guide us?



Together they will be exploring: **How good news brings life and how the feelings of joy and sadness can affect mine and other's behaviour. The new life of the Easter message is spread through the power of the Holy Spirit.**

They will be reading relevant scriptures: Acts 4 : 1-26 , 2 Corinthians 6: 3-10 , ,Acts 8: 26-30, 34-38 2

They will also be exploring the following themes which we encourage you to discuss with them at home:

	<p>Holy Spirit The Holy Spirit is our helper, teacher, comforter, and our friend! We can see The Holy Spirit in the joy, the courage and the strength that it gives. The Holy Spirit inspires us with good ideas and its gifts helps us to carry them out.</p>
	<p>Resurrection: Jesus died on the cross, was buried in a tomb, and after three days, God raised Him back to life.</p>
	<p>Pentecost Pentecost is celebrated 50 days after Easter and is when Christians remember the gift of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is the third part of the Trinity - Father, Son and Holy Spirit.</p>
	<p>Fellowship: "Our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son, Jesus Christ" (<u>1 John 1:3</u>). Fellowship means, having something in common.</p>
