This term our RE focus is Pentecost - Serving

The children's Big Question is: **How can energy transform?**

The children will be reflecting on this and asking: How can I transform my energy for the good of others? What do you think the disciples meant and what were their expectations, when they said 'the Promised One who would set Israel free'?



Together they will be exploring: **How decisions about the use of transforming energy are informed by belief and values. Pentecost; the celebration of the Spirit's transforming power**

They will be reading relevant scriptures: *Galatians: 5: 16-17, 22-23, Luke 24: 13-35, Acts 2: 32-39, 41-42, Acts 22: 6-1, Romans 8: 14-17 and the prayer, Come Holy Spirit,*

They will also be exploring the following themes which we encourage you to discuss with them at home:

	<p>Holy Spirit The Holy Spirit is our helper, teacher, comforter, and our friend! We can see The Holy Spirit in the joy, the courage and the strength that it gives. The Holy Spirit inspires us with good ideas and its gifts helps us to carry them out.</p>
	<p>Gift, Fruits of the Spirit: The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. All of these fruits are good to have and the Spirit wants to give them to us.</p>
